Our planet is collapsing

1°C

Temperature increase since preindustrial times... most ecosystems will struggle at 2°C warming

6th

Mass extinction¹... the first since the disappearance of the dinosaurs, and the first driven by humankind (a.k.a. the Anthropocene)

60%

Earth is in crisis: at the current rate of nature loss, up to 1 million species may become extinct, many within several decades




Major economic cost: amount of global crop output at risk due to pollinator loss is \$235 - \$577 billion



Global species extinction: 10 – 100s of times higher than the natural background rate, and the rate is accelerating



Our vision for a New Deal for Nature and People


- Reverse the loss of nature


